

Haus Juris Puppy Class

Welcome to Haus Juris puppy class! This introductory course will teach you and your new puppy the basics of obedience. It will also introduce the theory behind the sport of Schutzhund and aid in the socialization of your puppy. This curriculum outlines the objective of the next ten weeks.

In order to be well prepared for your first class, here are some basic guidelines:

- Never feed your puppy the morning of training. This helps to encourage the food drive, which is extremely important in the early stages of learning.
- Your puppy should not be allowed to play with other dogs, inside or outside of the family. It is crucial to training for the dog to bond with you.
- Always bring water with you to training
- Let your puppy go potty **before** stepping onto the training field

Some equipment you will need

- Crate! (Petco or Petsmart)
- 1 package of raw hotdogs
- 4 foot light weight leash, 3/8 inch preferred(Working Dog Outfitters, 719-597-7669- tell them you need a larger snap)
- 15 foot cotton leash
- Nylon collar or fursaver
- puppy's favorite toy or a jute

By the end of this course your puppy should know:

- Focus work
- Here in front (hier)
- Sit (sitz)
- Long Recall (hier)
- Long down (platz)
- Heeling work, beginning stages (fuss)

All dogs are different and will learn at different paces. Some may require additional training and/or different methods of training. Megan will help each individual with their dog.
